GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For most Certificates and Diplomas*:

- Academic IELTS of 6.0 no band less than 5.5
- High school and college transcripts (originals and translated copies)
- Copy of your passport
- Copy of your diplomas (Original and translated copies)

For Journalism, Music Business and Public Relations Diploma Programs*

For Post- Graduate Certificates*:

- Academic ILETS of 6.5 with no band less than 6.0
- High School and college transcripts (originals and translated copies)
- University transcripts (originals and translated copies)
- Copy of passport
- Copy of your diplomas (original and translated copies)

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES


The English Language Centre is located on the Durham College
Oshawa Campus, the ELC provides language pathways for
students who meet the academic requirements for admission to
Durham College but require addition English-language training.

Qualified students will receive conditional admission to their Durham College diploma or certificate program at the same time as they receive admission to the ELC.









How students transition to Durham College:

- EAP- 4000: When students successfully finish EAP-4000, direct entry to most diploma and certificate programs.
- EAP- 5000: When students successfully finish EAP-5000, direct entry to Durham College graduate certificate programs.
- EAP- 6000: When students successfully finish EAP-6000, direct entry to the Practical Nursing and Communicative Disorders Assistant programs

(Arrival Services is a form you will need to fill out and send to the International Office to arrange pickup from the airport and/or receive temporary accommodation if requested. You will be sent the Arrival Services form via email 6 weeks before classes begin.)

To make your arrival in Canada a smooth one, students can apply for First Night accommodation free of charge. Submit your Arrival Services form before the deadline on the document to reserve your room.
